According to the Texas Education Agency, the goal of the High-Quality Pre-Kindergarten Program is to "provide districts with an opportunity to expand or enhance high-quality prekindergarten programs for qualifying students." TEA has identified the following six family engagement components which must be incorporated into the local Family Engagement Plan:

- 1. Facilitate family-to-family support
- 2. Establish a network of community resources
- 3. Increase family participation in decision-making
- 4. Equip families with tools to enhance and extend learning

5. Develop staff skills in evidence-based practices that support families in meeting their children's learning benchmarks

6. Evaluate family engagement efforts and use evaluation for continuous improvement.

As mentioned above, a major component of expanding and enhancing any education program is a high-quality family engagement design.
